

#### **Course Structure**

To satisfactorily complete the program, students must complete 16 units, including three units from the English group (with at least two at Unit 3 or 4 level) and three sequences of Units 3 and 4 studies in subjects other than English.

AE also offers <u>Victorian Certificate of Education – Vocational Education and Training</u> (VCE VET) in Hospitality, which can lead directly to employment and further studies in the Certificate III in Cookery or Patisserie. VCE VET is a program in Victoria, Australia that allows secondary school students to gain practical, industry-relevant skills while completing their VCE.
